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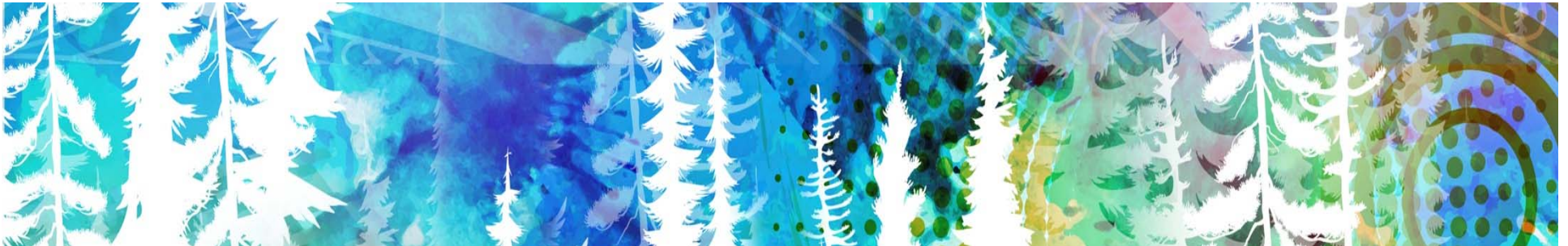

# ATOC Strategy 2017-2022

The ATOC Strategy is supported by an industry advisory committee and four working groups comprised of industry, tradespersons and ECE/Aurora College Staff.

Priority Areas identified for 2019-2020 include:

- Implementing a communications plan
- Encouraging women to enter the trades
- Exploring the use of essential skills assessments for trades entrance
- Introducing mentorship training for journeypersons







## Supports for Employers & Organizations

Employers and organizations have access to financial and programming supports to train tradespersons and those wishing to enter the trades

- Schools North Apprenticeship Program (SNAP)
- Wage Subsidies
- Training and Job Creation Programs

Individuals who are in the trades or interested in pursuing a trade also have a number of supports available to them including:

- Apprenticeship Grants and Loans
- Learning Assessments
- Skills Development Programs
- Self-employment Programs



# Housing Maintainer

Housing Maintainers are a unique northern trade; primarily employed by Housing Authorities in the NWT and NU.

- Yukon and British Columbia are both considering establishing trades and college programs for this trade
- Currently NWT is leading the occupational review and updating existing materials
- Excellent opportunity for communities and organizations to provide input and to reenergize this trade
