



HOMEOWNERSHIP REPAIR PROGRAM

Emergency Repair Program

Funding is available for eligible households to address emergency repairs that are urgently required to support the continued safe occupancy of the home.

Available Funding

Up to **\$15,000** is available to cover emergency repairs. More than one repair application can be approved in the same year as long as the repairs were unrelated, and the annual total does not exceed \$15,000.

Deadline

The Emergency Repair funding is offered on a **year-round** basis to all communities. Work must be completed within 60 days of the emergency

Eligibility

This funding is open to residents of the NWT who:

- have a health and safety emergency repair that is urgent, such as no heat during the cold season
- are over 19 years of age
- have owned and lived in their home for over a year, and in the NWT for three years
- own a home as the primary residence within municipal boundaries and have access to a continuous supply of electricity, potable water and heat
- own a home where there is a functional sewage containment system
- have a household income that falls below the Core Need Income Threshold (CNIT) for their community

How to Apply

To apply, you will need to contact your Housing NWT District Office by phone. Client counselling is required at all stages during the application process.
