



## HOMEOWNERSHIP REPAIR PROGRAM

# Fuel Tank Replacement

Funding is available to eligible households to upgrade their aging above ground fuel tanks.

### Available Funding

A one-time forgivable loan of up to **\$15,000** is available.

A co-pay of up to 10% of the repair costs is required for applicants whose income is over \$60,000.

### Deadline

The Fuel Tank Replacement Initiative will be offered on a **year-round** basis to all communities.

### Eligibility

Applications are open to residents of the NWT who:

- are over 19 years of age
- have owned and lived in their home for over a year, and in the NWT for three years
- own a home as the primary residence within municipal boundaries and have access to a continuous supply of electricity, potable water and heat
- own a home where there is a functional sewage containment system
- have a household income that falls below the Core Need Income Threshold (CNIT) for their community
- have a fuel tank in poor condition or not meeting current standards – including replacement of fuel tank and/or related components that are in poor condition and/or do not meet current CSA B-139-09 standard codes

### How to Apply

To apply, you will need to contact your Housing NWT District Office by phone.

Client counselling is required at all stages during the application process.
