HOMEOWNERSHIP REPAIR PROGRAM

Mobility Modifications

Funding is available to eligible households, with a household member that has a housing related disability, to support modifications that will promote continued independent living.

Available Funding

A forgivable loan of up to **\$50,000** is provided. The forgiveness period will be from one to five years, depending on the amount of assistance provided.

Deadline

The application intake period is **April 1 – October 31**, annually for work to be done in the following year, beginning April 1.

Eligibility

This funding is open to residents of the NWT who:

- are over 19 years of age
- can provide a letter or certificate from a qualified medical expert to confirm the related disability
- have lived in the NWT for three years and have lived in their home for over a year
- are homeowners with a disability or homeowners who have a household member with a disability that live in the house as their permanent residence
- have a household income that falls below the Core Need Income Threshold (CNIT) for their community
- are able to provide medical proof of required modifications

How to Apply

To apply, you will need to contact your Housing NWT District Office by phone.

Client counselling is required at all stages during the application process.
